The garden area is approximately 8 ha. (80 Dunam), half of which is irrigated and non-irrigated lawns. It contains also a botanical garden of 2,5 ha with a wide variety of plants, some native to Israel and others from all over the world.

Responsibility:

- Executing and developing the maintenance of the garden in an ecological approach.
- Mowing, weeding, spraying, cleaning paths, pruning, cutting dead wood, replanting.
- Maintaining and improving the irrigation systems for lawns and botanical garden respecting up to date findings of water saving management.
- Buying, planting and replanting flowers, bushes or trees in certain areas.
- Maintenance and correct use of garden equipment (machines and tools).
- Guiding tours with interested volunteers or guests through the garden. (optional)
- Providing written information for interested volunteers or guests. (optional)

Requirements:

- Practical work experience;
- A secondary or higher education of horticulture has the preference;
- Flexibility;
- A reasonable knowledge of English;
- Good communicative and social skills;
- Interest in the ideology and Christian background of Nes Ammim;
- Willingness to live in a small village community for a minimum period of one year.
